The students are prepared for the Indian Certificate of Secondary Education (I.C.S.E), New Delhi. The school has the recognition and affiliation to CISCE, New Delhi from 1994. Since June 2004 the school has been upgraded to Indian School Certificate (I.S.C. or Plus Two), Delhi, having Humanities, Science and Commerce streams. Besides St. Francis students who have unblemished record of character and fulfill the conditions set by the school, a few students from the other schools who are eligible will also be considered for the admission to Plus Two.



CURRICULUM

The medium of instruction is English but very special emphasis is given to Hindi, the national language, together with the essential subjects:- Sanskrit, History, Geography, Social studies, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Physical Training, Computer Application, Commercial Application, Psychology, Economics, Fine Arts etc. Keeping in mind, the unpardonable destruction being perpetrated on nature and ecology, Environmental Science has been included in the course of study. The school has well-equipped laboratories for science, modern computer lab and library to allow the pupils to develop and foster their innate talents and keep abreast with the modern education from the very beginning.

The school lays a great deal of stress on character formation and development of spiritual and ethical values which are imparted regularly to students through the teaching of Moral Science. The Social Service League (S.S.L.) actively encourages students to help generating the spirit of Service to Humankind and enhance the love for Socially Useful and Productive Work.

ADMISSION

1. A Transfer Certificate from the school last attended shall be presented at the time of admission to class I and above.
2. All students must produce proper Birth Certificate. A valid Birth Certificate from the Municipality/Panchayat is to be submitted at the time of admission to Nursery.
3. The candidate must be introduced personally to the Principal by his/ her parents who will be responsible for his/ her conduct and fees.
4. Boys and girls admitted to Nursery should be of minimum three years and nine months old. An interaction of the parents together with the child is required prior to admission.
5. Guardians are asked to fill in the admission form with utmost accuracy. No subsequent change will be permitted thereafter for any reason whatsoever.

FEES

1. Fees are collected in the Union Bank of India and the Oriental Bank of Commerce from 1st to 30th of April, July, October and January in installments or in advance, failing which a fine will be charged as per the instructions given in the fee book.
2. Parents will kindly save the receipts issued to them for counterchecking by the school office.
3. The school reserves its rights to revise the fees without prior notice.
4. The fee defaulters may be debarred from examinations and are liable to have their names struck off the rolls.
5. Fee once collected will not be refunded.
6. School fee will not be collected in the school office.



RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE PARENTS

1. Parents and guardians are requested to co-operate with the school authorities in all matters concerning formation and education of their child. Parents are to look into school diary every evening and see to it that the lesson and homework assigned for the next day are done. Remarks made in the diary by the Principal or the teachers should be seen and countersigned.
2. If the parents have any grievance against any teacher, they are advised to meet the Principal and settle the matter amicably.
3. Parents are always welcome to interview the Principal to discuss the progress of their children. To consult the teacher regarding the progress of their children an appointment is to be made through the Vice-Principal or the Principal for the free time of teachers or after class hours.
4. Please urge your wards to be regular and punctual in attendance and insist on neatness and cleanliness of their text books, exercise books and personal appearance.
5. No guardian is allowed to go into any class room or go upstairs without the specific permission from school authorities.
6. Admission to the other classes are open only if vacancy is available.
7. Admission Test and interview shall be conducted before they are admitted to any class.
